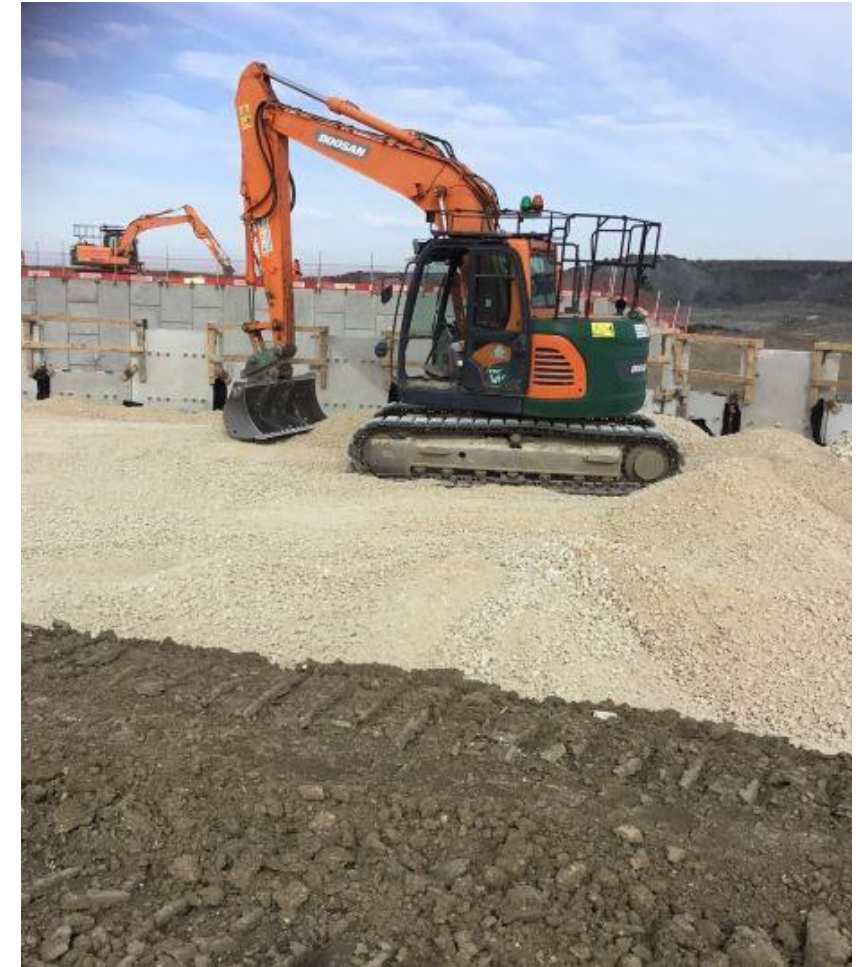

Levelling and compacting 6l abutment backfill for both
north and south ReCo walls



Successful completion of the northern ReCo wall is fast approaching here at DN7. The final panels and straps have been installed and the last layer of 6l stone is currently being placed and will be complete within a matter of days.



Works to construct the reinforced concrete bankseat will then follow on.

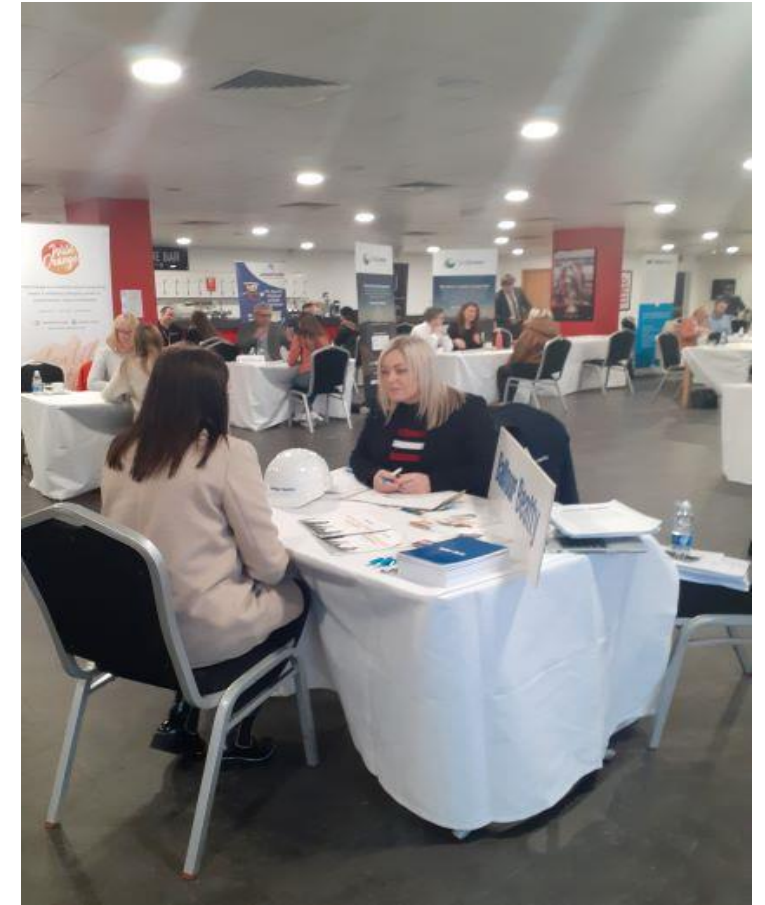
